SERVICE DEFINITIONS

Local drayage	Pick up and delivery from or to an intermodal ramp or port facility, generally less than 100 one-way miles.
Over-the-road drayage	Pick up and delivery from or to an intermodal ramp or port facility, greater than 100 one-way miles and includes 48-State Authority; OTR drayage may also include LCL service in addition to full container load handling.
Cross-border drayage	Service between the U.S. and Mexico or Canada.
Cross-town trucking	Short-haul and local service for ramp-to-ramp or ramp-to-pier pick up and delivery.
Regional trucking	Long-haul service within the primary service area or extending beyond on the basis of Pacer Cartage's 48-State Authority, not involving intermodal or port pick up and delivery; may include LTL service in addition to full truckload handling.
Hazmat loads	Capability to handle loads requiring USDOT hazardous materials placards; driver must have a qualified Hazmat endorsed CDL to accept this load.
Overweight loads	Capability to handle shipments exceeding 80,000 lbs gross weight (including vehicle) or state-specific maximum weight allowable or exceeding the legal bridge formula, which require special permits to be transported over the road.
Reefer loads	Capability to handle shipments requiring protective service for temperature control.
Chassis rental	Availability of over-the-road container chassis units for short-term rental.
Container lifts	Capability to lift/flip full and/or empty containers.
Customs-bonded	Capability to accept international inbound shipments "in bond", delaying payment of U.S. Customs duties and /or for re-export.
Container freight station	This facility is an officially designated U.S. Customs container inspection station, C-PAT compliant.
On-site or container yard storage	Storage services for container and/or chassis equipment on site, which may be a secured or non-secured facility.
Transloading	Capability, either directly or through contracted third party, to unload/reload freight from one equipment type to another, or to consolidate or deconsolidate loads for further shipment.
Warehousing	Capability, either on-site or through contracted third party, to accept freight for storage.
