



Pacer has gone clean in Southern California

As a SmartWay Transport Partner and participant in the Clean Trucks Program administered by the ports of Long Beach and Los Angeles, Pacer is increasing energy efficiency and improving air quality.



Pacer's Southern California carrier fleet (operated by Pacer Cartage, Inc., PDS Trucking, Inc. and Harbor Rail Transport, Inc.) has transitioned to 230 "clean trucks" that are predicted to improve air quality and reduce pollution by at least 45 percent in the next five years. The new truck program will also allow Pacer to help minimize our customers' exposure to the clean air fees that have recently been instituted by the ports of Los Angeles and Long Beach.

Since Pacer is committed to improving our environmental footprint, we will focus on the following to reduce emissions in our Southern California operations:

- Working with our owner operators to deploy 100 percent clean-burning diesel tractors serving the ports of LA and Long Beach
- Improving the fleet age by replacing older trucks with 2009 trucks and restricting the age of new owner-operator trucks
- Installing radio frequency identification (RFID) technology to gather data from tractor engine computers to track and measure fuel efficiency
- Educating drivers on speed management and engine idling techniques to reduce emissions
